City of Mount Vernon Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Plan Update - Request for Public Input

MOUNT VERNON - The City of Mount Vernon is updating the Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Plan, and Mayor Jill Boudreau and Mount Vernon Parks and Enrichment Services Director William King are seeking your input.
