

Do You Need an Interpreter For Court?

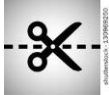
Do you have a case in the Mount Vernon Municipal Court? Do you have trouble speaking or understanding English?

You can ask for an interpreter to interpret in the courtroom for you, without cost to you.

IF YOU NEED AN INTERPRETER, THIS IS WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

Fill out the form below and take it to the Mount Vernon Municipal Court office, located at 1805 Continental Pl Mount Vernon WA 98273. Do this 2-5 days BEFORE your hearing. If you have more than one hearing, use additional forms.

If your hearing is cancelled or the date changes, you must immediately tell the Mount Vernon Municipal Court by calling (360) 336-6205 or in-person at the Court office located at 1805 Continental Pl Mount Vernon WA 98273. This will let the court cancel the interpreter.
