



CURRENT ACTIVITIES

Efforts into the month of August will continue to focus on the installation of mechanical, electrical and plumbing components, curing of the traffic coatings in the parking garage (Level 4, above left) and continued build-out activities on the first floor such as interior storefronts, paint, and installation of the library stacks shelving (above right). Landscaping and site improvements will also continue to transform the exterior of the building.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHT

The Mount Vernon Library Commons Project will feature wood wall panels of White Maple, rotary sliced, with a clear coat. Rotary slicing is a method of spirally slicing the wood from a log with a rotary lathe.

The wood panels are intended to provide warmth and a connection, interaction with nature. There are approximately 3900 square feet of wood wall panels throughout the building.



PROJECT TRAFFIC IMPACTS



3rd Street will be closed between W. Kincaid and W. Broadway for the duration of the project. Be alert for temporary traffic revisions along S. 2nd Street & Kincaid Street as the site finishes and landscaping activities take place over the next few months.
