Goal 1 – Implement technologies that improve efficiencies and effectiveness of fire personnel

Critical Tasks:

- Host quarterly trainings to increase staff efficiencies on existing computer programs and systems; i.e. Google Documents and Sheets, Telestaff, Microsoft Suite, RMS
- Review/purchase a software program that can improve reporting or access to needed data
- Redesign of department website to be a dynamic source of information available for the public
- Identify technology opportunities that can improve organizational communication and employee training:

<u>Goal 2</u> – Ensure that all personnel are achieving minimum training standards and advanced training opportunities are provided for career development

- Retain a level of 100% completion on all mandated training
- Maintain 100% EMT certification or Paramedic certification
- List initial and ongoing training needed by employees to perform successfully in their jobs
- Identify sources of training and education identified in the task above that are available internally and externally
- Provide quarterly development opportunities for company officers

- Conduct three training classes and one exercise for Emergency Operations Center staff
- Identify pre-requisite training required for each promotional position
- Develop opportunities for personnel to attend pre-requisite training

Goal 3 – Increase outside agency engagement and coordination

- Participate in regionalized hazardous materials, technical rescue and swift-water rescue meetings
- Identify similar programs and services provided by neighboring and other emergency response agencies
- Identify service delivery options for each program
- Complete a cost/benefit analysis for each service or program
- Select preferred delivery methodology from the identified options for each program
- Work with regional partners to develop a plan for specialty response
- Develop an implementation plan to achieve the outcome
- Invite regional partners to participate in EOC training and exercise

Goal 1 – Progress toward building a new library

Critical Tasks:

- Continue to work with City Council and Library Foundation on joint meetings and joint efforts to bring a new library to Mount Vernon
- Work with Library Foundation on at least one "the current and future library" presentation per quarter to a local organization
- Grow the supporter base for a new library, including helping the Foundation at least double its membership

Goal 2 – Improve functionality and look of the Mount Vernon City Library webpage and other online access points

Critical Tasks:

- Assign a committee to work on overall look and functionality of library web site
- Committee members will update content at least once a week
- Committee members will monitor Facebook page on a daily basis and post new material at least twice a week.

Goal 3 – Emphasize high quality Service and Service Delivery

- All staff members will familiarize themselves with the new Horizon upgrade software to better help patrons access the full range of new and enhanced offerings
- Continue to provide quality Early Learning programing, research and implement at least one new EL program added in 2017
- Continue to provide quality STEM/STEAM programming, research and implement at least one new STEM/STEAM program added in 2017
- Apply for at least two additional grant funded opportunities
- Staff teams will visit at least one exemplary service outlet to learn about work flow, facility layout and customer service best practices, and implement at least one service improvement based on what was learned.
- Open at least one off-site book return site and monitor usage/staff workload required
- Analyze user experience both in library and online, and come up with three improvements

Goal 4 — Maximize collaboration with other resources in Skagit County

- Continue highly successful Skagit Reads collaboration with other community partners
- Continue collaborations with Skagit Valley College, with at least two joint or partnered projects with SVC staff or programs
- Collaborate more fully with specific targeted agencies
